Will Elite Learning courses transfer to UVa-Wise? Many students complete their associate degree at the community college while other students choose to enroll directly into a four-year college or university. UVa-Wise is the college of choice for many students in Southwest Virginia. Students may be able to transfer their Elite Learning courses directly to UVa-Wise. Who evaluates courses to determine transferability? Student transcripts will be evaluated for transfer credit after he/she accepts UVa-Wise's offer for admission. The office of the dean of the college, or in some cases the department into which a student transfers, is responsible for this evaluation and for determining transfer credit awards. Keep this in mind when using the list of UVa-Wise courses and Virginia Community College (VCCS) transferable equivalents. The college may evaluate and change course equivalents. Elite Learning cannot guarantee transferability of any course.

What if a student completes his/her associate degree before applying to UVA @ Wise? Students who complete the right courses and earn an associate degree with a strong grade point average can be assured admission to UVa-Wise under the Guarantee Admission Program. Restrictions apply.
